Kings County Enterprise Zone

Eligibility Criteria and Documentation for Voucher Application

1. A person who is eligible for services through the Workforce Investment Act (WIA). The WIA is managed by the Job Training Office in Hanford.

Individuals may call the Kings County EDC (585-3576) for an appointment with the Job Training Office to determine eligibility. Individuals currently receiving WIA services at the Job Training Office can be issued the Voucher Certificate directly.

2. Individual receiving services through Welfare to Work.

Documentation validating receipt of Welfare to Work Services/TANF (Public Assistance).

3. An individual eligible for WOTC through Employment Development Department

A WOTC (Work Opportunity Tax Credit) certificate issued by the Employment Development Department for federal tax credits.

4. An Economically Disadvantage Individual as defined: at least 14 years of age, and resides in a household with a total family income not exceeding the very low income category.

An Identification Card/Driver's License, Income verification and the Income Verification Worksheet.

5. A Dislocated Worker due to massive layoff or business closure.

Documentation (letter, newspaper article etc) of plant closure or substantial lay off.

6. Disabled individual enrolled in or completed a State rehabilitation plan.

A letter from the State Rehabilitation Department.

7. Disabled Veteran

DD214 validating a service connected disability.

8. Vietnam Veteran

DD214 validating dates of service.

9. A recently released (48 month prior to hire) Veteran.

DD214 validating separation date within 48 months of hire date. (Note: anyone still active in the military is not considered a Veteran until actual separation from the military).

10. An Ex-Offender-Individual charged with a Misdemeanor or Felony.

Release papers/court documents validating the misdemeanor or felony offense.

11. Individual who received/receiving Public Assistance (TANF (Cash Aid)/Food Stamps/General Assistance) or Supplemental Support Insurance (SSI).

A Passport to Services from the Human Services Agency for Kings County residents or other documentation validating receipt of TANF (Public Assistance/Food Stamps) for other county residents. Individual received/receiving SSI can obtain a letter of validation from the Social Security Office.

12. Native American

A document validating membership in a government recognized tribe.

13. Resident of Targeted Employment Area (TEA)

Form I-9, Driver's license or State Identification Card, Landlord statement, Lease or rental agreement or Utility bill. This verification must match Application Voucher date of hire.
